

Update from your Board – January 2022



No Jab, No Entry from 10 January 2022

From 10 January 2022 all visitors to the club must be fully vaccinated. This applies to all members, social bowlers, Night Owls, spectators, tradespeople and any other person that comes through the gate.

We are doing this as we believe it is the right thing to do to keep all of us safe from the harm that COVID-19 can cause to us our families and the wider community.

Please be aware that a Covid Marshall or Board Member may ask to see proof of your vaccination status. We've already done this for all the Pennant bowlers and have attached a note to the player's BowlsLink Member Details, so we we'll only need to check a few spectators on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

COVID-19 Restrictions

The current COVID-19 control measures mean that all food and drink must be consumed whilst seated. The number of people allowed in the club rooms and bar area are also reduced – only 23 in the bar area & 48 in the dining room. This will make the afternoon tea break(s) very interesting.

Remember to check in via the QR Code ... and to wear a mask indoors ... and don't touch other people ... and sanitise your hands & anything you touch ... and stay away if you're not feeling well.

Of course, now that we have a new permanent BBQ set-up in the shed ... we need to clean house and get rid of some junk. Allan is waiting for a cool day in January or February and he'll send out a call for volunteers to help out.

We think we might be able to use them for a bit of cooling in the spring or autumn when we're not using the evaporative AC. Work to commence sometime soon.
