If you have a legitimate need to answer a call, let the Umpire of the Day know before the game starts, keep your phone on silent / mute and answer any calls on the bank away from play.

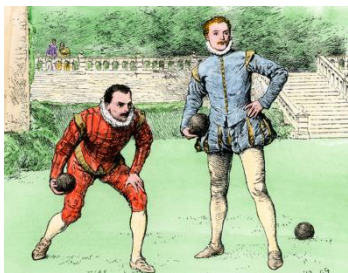


Afternoon Tea

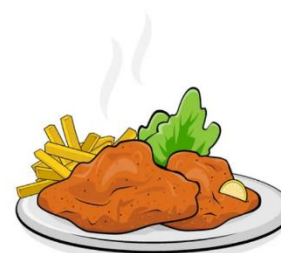


The December / Christmas one will be our Christmas break up and include a meal and live music. Further details will be circulated / posted soon.


